BEGINNING TO END, the HOSPITALITY HOUSE IS MORE THAN 'JUST' A PLACE TO STAY

From the joyful beginning of one little boy's life journey to the peaceful last moments as another man completed his, the Hospitality House has provided more than just a place to shower and sleep. The beauty and comfort of the home are welcoming to all who enter, but it is the warmth, compassion and attention to detail of the people who work there that make a true difference in the lives of its guests.

In 2015, more than 1,000 guests stayed at the Hospitality House while they cared for loved ones at The Medical Center or Commonwealth Regional Specialty Hospital. Kenny Neidergerke and Wayne Reno were just two of the guests who are remembered very fondly because of the unique situations that brought them to, and from, the Hospitality House. In the early months of 2015, the House received a

referral to lodge an adult couple who were driving from Missouri across country to get to Bowling Green in time for the birth of the son they intended to adopt. Like all new parents, Nick and Christina Niedergerke wanted to stay as close to their new baby as possible and the Hospitality House filled that immediate need.

Kenny was a beautiful, healthy baby boy and two days after his birth, the Niedergerke's were allowed to take Kenny from the hospital. But due to adoption law, they were not permitted to leave the state for several more days. The family, who by then had been joined by both maternal mothers, asked about affordable hotels in the area. The staff made another suggestion. The family was offered accommodations in a small apartment at the Hospitality House. The apartment was set apart from the regular guest rooms and

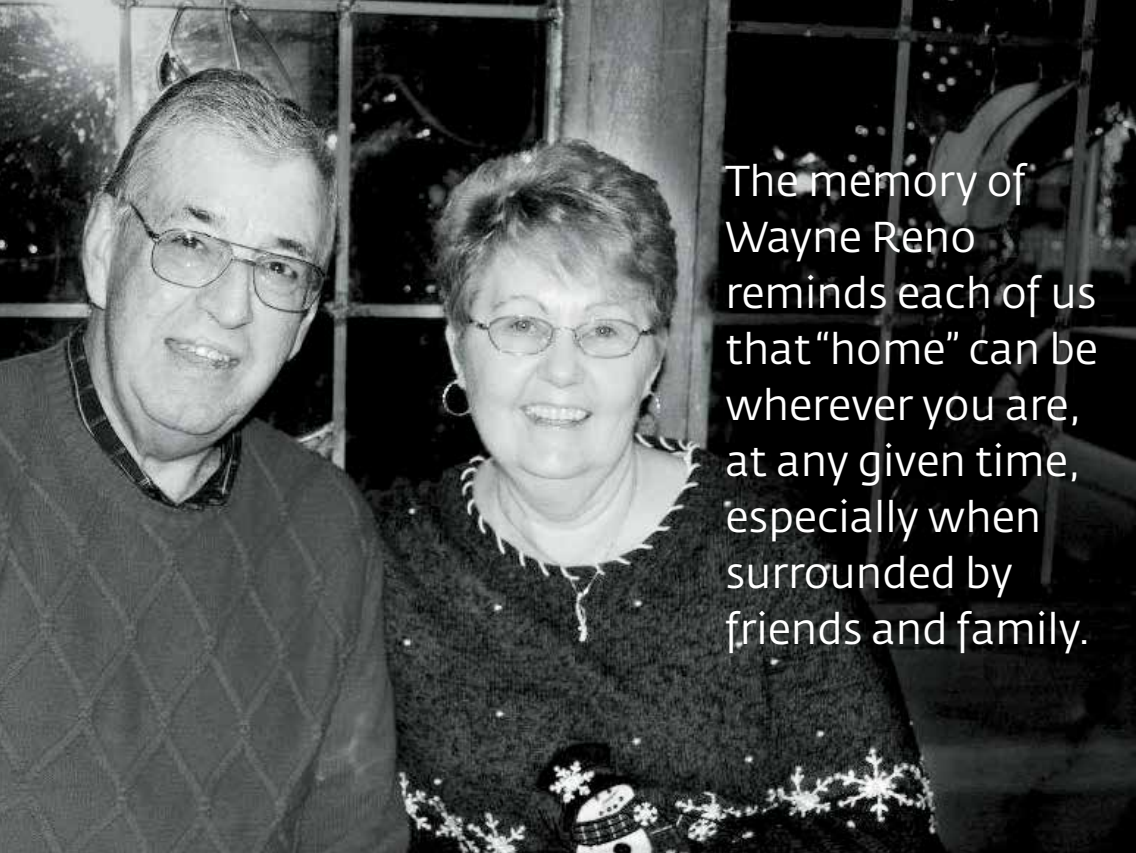

This home was built from the contributions of donors who believed in ensuring comfort to those who need a home while loved ones are receiving care at one of our facilities. The Foundation continues to emphasize the importance of raising funds for the Hospitality House Endowment. This endowment will ensure the operational stability of the House for years

to come. Currently it takes approximately \$250,000 to operate the House annually. Guests can stay at the home free of charge and donations are welcome. Gifts to the endowment can be made in any amount and allows donors to know their gifts will continue to bless the lives of patients and patient's families year after year.

provided ample space for the family to stay together for their first week. The joy of having this blessing in the House was contagious as he inspired many other guests with the wonders of new life!

Unfortunately, for every joy of birth there is sadness of death, and the memory of Wayne Reno reminds each of us that “home” can be wherever you are, at any given time, especially when surrounded by friends and family.

Mr. Reno represented the many guests who stay at the House who are patients at the hospital in need of daily outpatient treatment. Fighting a rare brain cancer, Mr. Reno stayed at the Hospitality House between treatments at the Cancer Center. As his treatment continued, it was obvious his illness was taking a physical toll. When family learned he needed to be moved to a hospice care facility as soon as possible, his daughter asked if he could stay at the House one more weekend as arrangements were made.

The family was moved to the apartment where baby Kenny’s family had stayed earlier that year. There, the family gathered around the dining room table for what turned out to be their last family meal together. Wayne Reno passed away the following evening surrounded by his family and friends at the Hospitality House - “a home away from home.”

NICOLE COLTRIN

Nicole Coltrin, a 36-year-old working mother was diagnosed with cancer on November 5, 2015. She has gone through several surgeries including a mastectomy. Right before Christmas, Nicole began her chemotherapy treatments, which would be followed by radiation. She concluded these treatments in June 2016 and then had surgery to remove her ovaries. Nicole's journey has been financially tolling and stressful for her family.

Many patients like Nicole walk through the doors of the Cancer Center each day. “It's difficult to hear stories where you wish you could fix it, but it is rewarding to know you are making a difference by providing resources, a listening ear and by letting patients know they are not alone. We try to help them feel prepared for whatever those next steps may be.” said Melanie Wilson, who was her Oncology Patient Navigator at the time.

Cancer happens to a person, not a number. Each person has her journey, his experience, her feelings,

his attitude. Facing that journey is why The Medical Center provides navigation services to help those affected by cancer. “Melanie has been a blessing to me,” states Nicole. “Being so young, I had no one to turn to and no idea how any of this worked.”

Compassionate – caring – dependable – a friendly face. These are the words to describe the cancer staff who ensure that support, knowledge and help are provided each day. The Medical Center prides itself to always have the most sophisticated technology for these procedures, but let us not forget our greatest assets – our employees. Victoria Kelly of Bowling Green has spent a lot of time around horses. Many years ago, Victoria, who has autism, began participating in a therapeutic horseback riding program for people with special needs. She loved riding, and it became the highlight of her week. Over time, Victoria made so much progress she was able to ride independently.

DISASTER STRIKES

So when Victoria began putting her horse through its paces with her instructor one September day in 2013, no one could have foreseen the accident. It happened so quickly. Victoria was leaning toward the left doing an exercise and the horse was spooked and went to the right. Victoria lost her balance and fell.

“She was on the ground and tried to get up but couldn’t,” says her father, John Kelly. “Her mother and I feared the worst.”

Victoria was rushed by ambulance to The Medical Center, and imaging tests were performed right away. The results showed she had broken a vertebra in her lower back. She needed surgery immediately.

PICKING UP THE PIECES

During a nine-hour operation, Narendra Nathoo, M.D., a neurosurgeon on the staff at The Medical Center, stabilized Victoria’s spine with metal rods and screws placed through an incision in her back. Victoria spent 12 days in the hospital, three of which in the Intensive Care Unit, before being discharged. For the next several months, her parents tended to her round-the-clock. Victoria did physical therapy exercises at home, and in time she recovered.

“She’s a tough little cookie,” says John. “Victoria still has some stiffness, which is to be expected, and she’s careful about bending at the knees now,” he adds. “She’s able to do all of the activities she enjoyed before. Dr. Nathoo and his team did a remarkable job.”

2015. The funds will be used for continuing education for the neurosurgical staff at The Medical Center. The Victoria Kelly Neurosurgery Education Fund allots \$10,000 each year for five years, enabling the hospital's newly opened Neurosurgical Unit to provide an even higher level of care.

"We thank the Kelly family for their kind generosity and for giving so selflessly to improve care for other patients needing brain or spine surgery," Dr. Nathoo says. "The field of neurosurgery is continually evolving, and the Kellys' gift will enable us to provide ongoing education for our doctors and nurses that will raise the bar even higher for our Neurosurgical Unit."

The Kellys' relationship with The Medical Center dates back many years, providing financial support to Commonwealth Health Free Clinic, the Hospitality House and Barren River Adult Day Care Center. John and Linda also pioneered services in Bowling Green for people with autism. They founded the Kelly Autism Program (KAP) at Western Kentucky University (WKU), which provides educational, recreational and employment opportunities for participants and families.

The Medical Center's Neurosurgical Unit—the first of its kind in Southcentral Kentucky—is a six-bed unit providing specialized care for critical care patients and patients undergoing brain or spine surgery. Conditions treated include traumatic brain injuries, intracranial hemorrhage, strokes, brain tumors, spinal cord injuries and neck and back pain. Narendra Nathoo, M.D., a neurosurgeon on the staff at The Medical Center says, "One of the advantages of the new Neurosurgical Unit is patients can remain in the same location as they move through different stages of their recovery. As a result, they receive care from the same nurses throughout their stay."

EXCEEDING EXPECTATIONS

The Kellys say they couldn't have asked for more from the neurosurgical staff at The Medical Center.

Victoria, now 28, is nonverbal but communicates effectively by making gestures, using sign language and an iPad. The family understandably was concerned about how well the medical staff would be able to interact with her. As it turned out, those fears were unfounded.

“We saw our lives flashing before our eyes. We had no idea what the outcome would be. To see Victoria doing everything she did before is just tremendous.”

"The whole team showed great sensitivity and compassion for Victoria and communicated with her effectively through her recovery," John says. "Victoria picks up on your emotions. If you deal with her in a soft, tender way, you'll get a positive response."

DOING WELL

Because of her accident, Victoria had to give up riding horses, but she has plenty of other activities that keep her busy. Three days a week, she lunches with a friend from KAP. She also swims at a local health club, walks with her personal trainer, performs clerical tasks for WKU at home and helps around the house.

"We saw our lives flashing before our eyes," says John. "We had no idea what the outcome would be. To see Victoria doing everything she did before is just tremendous. We remember every day how lucky we are to have her with us and that Dr. Nathoo and The Medical Center took on that challenge."

THE MEDICAL CENTER - WKU

HEALTH SCIENCE COMPLEX



Since opening The Medical Center - WKU Health Science Complex in 2013, the addition of a computer and a simulation lab has impacted the skills and competence of Commonwealth Health Corporation staff. The Simulation Lab now houses simulators for training in caring for patients who are critically ill, who have suffered trauma, who have had surgery, who are in childbirth, and who range in age from newborn, infant, children and adults. The gifts of patient simulators from the community has enabled us to design patient care scenarios very similar to what is experienced by staff in our hospital. To date, there have been 135 simulations and 620 staff impacted by those simulations.

Research has shown that learning is more likely to occur, if the learner understands their need to know. Simulation creates the "need to know," experience. The realism of simulation allows the learner to be held accountable to know what to do and to make the right decisions. Those decisions are on their shoulders and it is all up to them to save a life and it is a powerful moment.

Thank you for giving us the tools to create those powerful moments. Because of those moments, our staff are better prepared to make the right decisions that might impact the life of someone you love.

OFFERS FLEXIBLE, ACCESSIBLE CARE

For nearly 20 years, Commonwealth Health Free Clinic has served patients in our area who are employed but who have no insurance and nowhere else to go for their healthcare needs. The Clinic has made a huge difference in the lives of many people in the 10-county Barren River Area Development District (BRADD). Now, in part because of changes in healthcare law and also due to increased demand among patients who fall into the healthcare “gap,” the Clinic has taken a huge step forward to better serve our friends and neighbors.

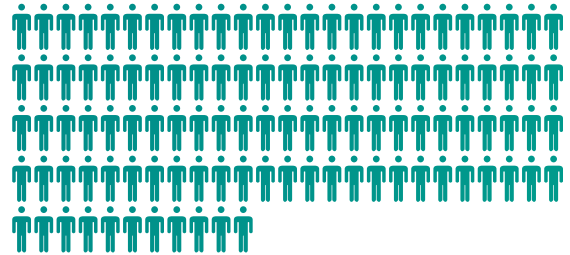
In October 2015, Commonwealth Health Free Clinic became Community Clinic, a charitable healthcare clinic for the uninsured and underinsured in our region, regardless of their employment status. In the past, the Clinic was open Tuesdays and Thursdays during the evening hours and could serve only a very limited number of patients who were working but who did not have insurance. With this change, the Clinic is now open Monday through Thursday, with either morning or afternoon appointments.

From the inception of the Free Clinic two decades ago, provision of dental services has always been included in the overall scope of care made available to patients.

Last year The Dental Clinic provided appointments to more than 2,200 individual patients. In excess of 6,400 separate services such as fillings, x-rays, extractions and cleanings were provided during those patient visits. In addition to the basic services provided on site, The Dental Clinic also assists with referrals for specialty care such as oral surgical extractions and denture assistance for their patients.
