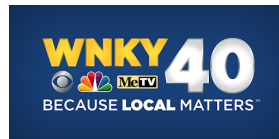

Disclaimer

The American Cancer Society will be requiring all individuals attending this year's Purses, Pouts, and Pearls event to show proof of vaccination OR a negative COVID-19 test result within 24 hours of the event. Each attendee will receive a link to the provided email that will direct them to an online system, CLEARED4. Through this system, they will upload a picture of the front and back of their vaccination card OR request an at-home COVID-19 test. The test will be delivered to the address provided by the attendee in the CLEARED4 system, free of charge prior to the event. The test must be administered within 24 hours of the event and a picture of the negative test results uploaded into the CLEARED4 system. An individual that tests positive for COVID-19 will not be permitted at the event and no refund would be issued. We appreciate your understanding as the American Cancer Society, a health organization, takes the necessary steps to protect our community. If you are unable to attend, we hope you will continue to support our mission by donating.
